WHAT WE'RE LEARNING THIS MONTH...

READING — The class will be reading realistic fiction, a folk tale, and a fairy tale this month. We will concentrate on the following comprehension skills and strategies:

- *character and setting
- *sequencing
- *main idea and details
- *text structure
- *realism and fantasy
- *drawing conclusions

SPELLING/PHONICS...

The students will work on the following skills:

- *r-controlled vowels(ar,or,ore,er,ir,ur)
- *Contractions
- *Plurals (adding –s and –es)
- *Consonant digraphs (th, sh, wh, ch)
- *Long a (a, ai, ay)

SOCIAL STUDIES- The

class will learn about cultural heritage this month. We will experience this first hand as we visit Conner Prairie.

SCIENCE-This month we will be observing and identifying different features of plants and animals. We will investigate by observing how animals and plants sometimes cause changes in their surroundings.

ENGLISH-Nouns, Nouns, Nouns! This month we will be emphasizing nouns. We will learn about nouns, proper nouns, singular and plural nouns, plural nouns that change spelling and possessive nouns.

MATH- In Math we will continue to work with the math facts. We will also reinforce place value. We will continue working with fractions and telling time to the half hour. In addition we will continue working with money – pennies, dimes and nickels
