# Accelerated Reader/ READING WALL OF FAME



The purpose of Accelerated Reader is to improve reading comprehension. <u>I</u>

# expect each student to read a book and pass at least one test each week.

Students can take a test every day before going out to recess and during our computer and library time. The children should take their A.R. book home if they don't have time to read it during class and bring it back to school to take a test. I recommend taking a book home on Friday and reading it over the weekend. Your child can read as many books as he/she wishes a week: however each student is only required to pass one test per week. The AR quiz must be taken by the end of the day on Wednesday or your child will have to read and take a test during first recess. Each quiz passed earns the child one point. To earn a star on our READING WALL OF FAME in the hallway, your child must earn 30 points. He/she will move up the Wall Of Fame as they earn more points. Each child will earn a reward at each level, beginning with 10 points. You will receive an Accelerated Reader report each Friday (if the computers and printers are working. (2) I appreciate your support as we strive to help your child become the best reader possible.

## WHAT WE'RE LEARNING THIS MONTH...

**READING** — The class will be reading realistic fiction, expository nonfiction, and a play this month. We will concentrate on the following

- comprehension skills and strategies:
- \*character and setting
- \*main idea and detail
- \*text structure
- \*realism and fantasy
- \*drawing conclusions

### SPELLING/PHONICS...

The students will work on the following skills:

- \*inflectional endings (-s,-ed,-ing)
- \*consonant blends (gr, sl, st, bl..)
- \*consonant digraphs (th, sh, wh, ch)
- \*words with ar. or. and ore

### SOCIAL STUDIES- Our

class will be learning and review the Six Pillars of Character; trustworthiness, respect, responsibility, fairness, caring and citizenship. They will also learn about the Constitution, our flag and how to read a compass rose.

SCIENCE- We will begin our study of Physical Science. We will learn about Properties of Matter, Energy, Magnet, Forces and Motion and Sound. The students will be switching classes for this unit of study. Mrs. Anderson, Mrs. Courtney, and I will be team teaching this unit.

**ENGLISH-**We will learn about predicates and review subjects. We will learn about statements, questions, commands, and exclamation sentences. The students will write brief narrative stories using Voice as they add descriptive words (adjectives) in their writings. They will continue to distinguish between complete and incomplete sentences.


**MATH-** We will work on the

following concepts in math:

- \*Identifying addends, counting dimes and pennies, fact families, identifying geometric shapes
- \*The Commutative Property of addition \*Time, Ordinal numbers, Fractions
- \*Adding 2, doubles +1
